I was then ordered to proceed to Commerce, Missouri, and organize a force for operations against New Madrid and Island No.10. I commanded the force thus organized, known as the army of the Mississippi, during the reduction of those places and the subsequent operations around Corinth. On the 21st of March, 1862, I was promoted major general of volunteers. In June, 1862, I was ordered to Washington and placed in command of the army of Virginia, which consisted of three army corps, commanded respectively by Generals Fiemont, Banks, and McDowell. On the 14th of July I was appointed brigadier general in the regular army....
