Beautiful cubic crystals soon appeared; the whole was evaporated to dryness in order to examine this salt, which with the usual tests, unnecessary here to repeat, was found to be wholly muriat of soda or common salt. The last or third solution, which consisted of 25 grains, taken up by the distilled vinegar, was next examined to discover whether it consisted wholly or in part of carbonat of lime, or wholly or in part of carbonat of magnesia; for this purpose it was evaporated slowly till a viscid mass was obtained, which could not be brought to crystallize, and which was deliquescent.
