I have therefore in the main followed Mr. Sutherland s story, though here and there I have pointed out inaccuracies in detail, such as the fact that Gordon s only child who died at ten months old, was a girl and not a boy, and also that Gordon spent the last night before his death in a rather different fashion from that his biographer alleges.
