Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts efforts to define and implement: (1) facility management positions; (2) a facility management system; and (3) facility project and financial reports. GAO noted that: (1) the Center managers, including the Board of Trustees, determined that the Centers facility management program would be operated by a few managers supported by a small in-house staff and contractor technical staff; (2) currently, six facility-related managerial positions have been established and, according to Center officials, they do not anticipate a need for additional positions in the future; (3) the six managerial positions include the Vice President for Facilities; the Directors of Contracting, Facilities, Security, and Auxiliary Services; and the Project Executive; (4) all but the Vice President for Facilities and the Director of Auxiliary Services positions were established in 1994 and 1995; (5) in August and September 1996, the Center created the Director of Auxiliary Services and Vice President for Facilities positions, respectively; (6) with the exception of the Vice President for Facilities, the managers in...
