The regulations es-tablish minimum standards of character for all positions in the In-dian Health Service (IHS) where duties and responsibilities involve regular contact with children. All Indian Tribes or Tribal organiza-tions receiving funds under the authority of the Indian Self-Deter-mination and Education Assistance Act, as amended, must employ only individuals who meet standards of character no less stringent than those...
